Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirement) Regulations, 2015, we are glad to inform you that, the Company "Tara Chand Logistic Solutions Limited" has been awarded a contract for Installation of Cast In-Situ Piles at the Sarai Kale Khan Station of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Rapid Rail Transit System (RRTS) being constructed by Afcons Infrastructure Limited under contract with National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC). The Sarai Kale Khan is one of the most critical RRTS stations where all the three priority corridors of the system will converge.

The total work order value is INR 6.65 Crores to be executed over ten months. The Tara Chand team has successfully executed the first pile of 52-meter depth (within the stipulated time and without any collapsing of soil strata) using its new Hydraulic Piling Rig (SANY SR235) acquired in March 2020. This a phenomenal achievement for the company considering that the company entered the new business domain of Piling in FY 2018-19 with deployment of two brand new rigs on equipment rental basis in Bangalore Metro Project. In just three years, the company has progressed from being just a rental entity to providing a complete end-to-end solution for Piling Foundation works, which are one of the most critical activities in large infrastructure development works.
